Day 7: Misty Waves Boutique Hotel, Hermanus

Day Itinerary

Depending on the season and weather we will either do a Whale Watching Boat Cruise (July – Mid Dec) or Wine Tour in the Hemel and Aarde Valley (Mid Dec- July)



Whale Cruise

We start our trip from the Kleinbaai Harbour (east of Danger Point). From there we move towards the Pearly Beach area where we find our highest concentration of Southern right whales (Jul to mid-Dec). The Southern right whales come to our calm bays every year from July to December to calve and nurse their young or to mate. After spending the allowed time with these magnificent creatures, we move towards Dyer Island where we view the African penguins as well as various other seabirds. Behind Dyer Island we visit Geyser Rock, which is resident to about 60 000 Cape fur seals. Between these two Islands we find ourselves in Shark Alley. Shark Alley is world famous for its Great White sharks, which makes this probably the only trip in the world where you have a chance of seeing a Southern right whale as well as an 80 % chance of seeing a Great White shark. After this exhilarating 2 and a half hour trip we return to the Kleinbaai harbour to enjoy some refreshments at The Great White House.

All our trips are weather dependant. Our clients meet us at The Great White House in Kleinbaai at least half an hour before launching time (to be confirmed). All our clients must dress warmly and wear comfortable shoes. You must confirm the trip at least one day in advance, as well as the morning of the trip. Booking is essential. Please take seasickness medication well in advance if you are prone to motion sickness.

OR

Hemel and Aarde Wine Tour

Explore the breathtaking beauty and exceptional wines of the Hemel-en-Aarde Valley on this unforgettable day tour. Your journey begins with two morning wine tastings at renowned estates nestled among rolling vineyards and mountain. Terms and Conditions

ADVENTURESHOP STELLENBOSCH (herein “the Company”)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. How to Book:

Complete the Booking form, accepting on behalf of all party the terms of these booking conditions and pay a non-refundable deposit of 25% per person of the total Tour fare. No contract shall exist between the company and the client until the prescribed deposit has been paid and the clients booking on their signed booking form has been confirmed by the Company. The deposit will be refundable should the company not be able to accommodate the client on the requested tour. These terms and conditions may differ from operator to operator.

2. Payment:

The full payment of the tour fare due by the client to the Company must be paid by no longer than 4 weeks prior to date of departure of all tours, otherwise the Company may treat the booking as been cancelled by the client. Late applications may however join the tour on an availability basis. These terms and conditions may differ from operator to operator.

3. Cancellation by Client:

Cancellation of a booking must be in writing, by the person who made the booking, and is not effective until the Company receives such cancellation.

DAY TOURS:

- Cancellation 30 days – 8 days before departure: 90% refund.
- Cancellation 7 days – 3 days before departure: 50% refund.
- Cancellation 2 days or less before departure, or no-show: no refund.

STANDARD CANCELLATION for MULTI-DAY TOURS:

- Cancellation 31+ days before departure: 85% refund.
- Cancellation 30 days – 15 days before departure: 50% refund.
- Cancellation 14 days or less before departure or no show for departure, no refund

REFUND:

All Adventureshop tours are priced in South African Rand (R or ZAR). In case of a refund, any amount will be refunded in South African Rand, which then gets converted to your local currency by your bank or credit card company. Please note that due to currency fluctuations, the refund amount in your local currency might be higher or lower than the amount originally paid. In the case where a tour is paid for in a foreign currency, such as Euros or US Dollars, you will be informed of the amount received in Rand, and any refunds will be calculated based on the Rand amount received.

We strongly recommend that clients take out travel insurance to cover fees in case of cancellations or other unforeseen circumstances

4. Cancellation by the company:

The Company reserves the right to cancel the tour, in any circumstances, and all tours shall operate subject to a minimum participant on the tour. In instance where the company cannot provide the tour booked, the Company will return to the client all monies paid, which shall constitute the full extent of the Companies liability to the client, or the Company may offer the client an alternative holiday of comparable standard. These terms and conditions may differ from operator to operator.

5. Alterations to Itineraries:

Although every effort is made to adhere to itineraries printed in the brochure, the company reserves the right to occasionally change routes and accommodation as brought about by changing conditions. When a major change becomes necessary, notification of such alterations will be sent to the client's agent or to the client's last known addresses soon as the company becomes aware. The company reserves the right to alter an itinerary after a departure if it is in the client's interest to do so. The company will not be held responsible for any compensation to the client if the Company have to cancel or in the way change the tour due to force majeure, namely war, riot, civil strife, industrial dispute, terrorist activity, natural or nuclear disaster, fire, adverse weather conditions or other external circumstance beyond the Company's control. 6. Authority on Tour / Exclusion of Tour:

The decision of the driver guide of the Company will be final in all matters likely to endanger the safety of the clients of the group. The client may be excluded from the tour without any refund of the tour fare. If the Company considers the client as unsuitable for a tour, it may in its absolute discretion, cancel such a client booking to carry the client further if that client causes inconvenience or annoyance to other passengers. 7. Alterations:

No employee or representative of the Company has the right to alter, vary, waive the right of these conditions, nor to undertake any liability whatsoever on behalf of the Company, unless such be in writing and signed by the director of the Company. 8. Health:

The Company does not accept responsibility whatsoever for any client refused entry to any country due to incorrect or incomplete health documents or vaccinations. 10. Baggage:

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11. Travel Documentation:
